(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023

1. These Regulation may be cited as the Land Transport Regulatory Authority (Private Hire Services) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023 and shall be read as one with the Land Transport Regulatory Authority (Private Hire Services) Regulations, 2020 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

Amendment of
regulation 3

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3 by adding in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definitions:

“authorized agent” means a person, government institution, company or cooperative society appointed by the Authority to issue, renew licence or to perform such other functions on behalf of the Authority as may be determined by the Authority;

“interfere” means engaging, taking part, enter into, or using bus stop, or stations designed for operations other than private hire service operation;”.

Amendment of
regulation 4

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4 by inserting the words “or an authorized agent” between the words “Authority” and” for”.

Amendment of
regulation 15

4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 15, by-

- (a) inserting the word “and” at the end of paragraph (1) after semicolon;
- (b) deleting semicolon and the word “and” appearing in the end of paragraph (m) and substitution for it a full stop; and
- (c) deleting paragraph (n).

Amendment of
regulation 16

5. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 16(d) by deleting the word “authority” and replacing for it with the word “relevant authority in consultation with the licensee”.

Amendment of
regulation 17

6. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 17 by adding the word “permanent” immediately before the word “colour” appearing in paragraph (b).
